Te Runanga O Whaingaroa

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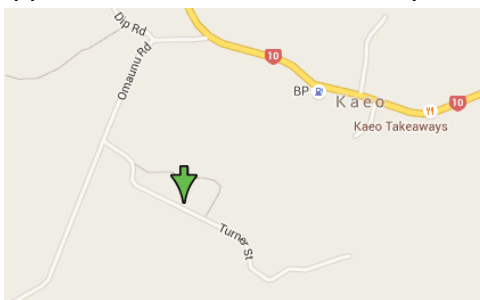
Where is Te Nohoanga located?

Te Nohoanga is located on the Whangaroa Harbour at 320 Whangaroa Road



Where is He Whare Awhina located?

What is Transitional Housing

Te Rūnanga O Whaingaroa provides safe, quality, affordable accommodation for low income families who cannot access Government supplied accommodation and/or private rental.

Short Term Emergency Housing is for those in desperate housing need and are often homeless or in dire overcrowding situations.

There is a referral and interview process for the emergency housing and occupancy rules which must be agreed to prior to taking on accommodations.

How long can I Stay?

The maximum stay in one of our Short Term properties is normally three months, although there is provision for a longer stay after consultation with the Runanga.

How much does it Cost?

You will be required to pay a rent contribution which is calculated at a maximum of 25% of your total income.

It is important that you are enrolled in our financial capability course during your stay which are delivered at the complexes.

Our Complexes

He Whare Awhina has 5 *Single Units*. Each are fully furnished self contained units.

Te Nohoanga has 14 units with communal kitchens, dining and shower toilet facilities.

Waikare has two semi furnished two bedroom units.

Our Approach

We enter into an agreement with you that is much more than just accommodation.

We provide a Whanau Ora Social Worker to assist you with life plans and moving forward. The Social Worker is on site at least one day per week.

Runanga's own wrap around support services such as counselling, budget advice, or Food Bank, Social Housing etc.

Often we will run services out of the complexes, including cooking classes, etc.

Working with Te Rūnanga O Whaingaroa means you have a supportive and helpful network around you.

Please Note: Social Worker and Financial capability programmes are compulsory .

How to apply

All applications for Transitional Housing are processed through The Ministry of Social Development. Your local Work and Income office will be able to advise you on eligibility and options available.
